

Isabelle loves him very much, she is ready to do anything for him, but the meeting with Davide, a young man who is going through a difficult time, will alter the course of their lives and Isabelle will have to make a choice, the consequences of which will be devastating.

Director's note




When I started to think of a direction for Isabelle, I forced myself to avoid the stereotypes of genre cinema, to the advantage of the most intimate aspects of the individual characters, all unable to manage a role that life has reserved for them, despite themselves.

I have always thought of Isabelle as one of those characters in the bourgeois theater of Augier or Dumas, who carry the game of life and death on the stage, struggling against themselves and their value system in order to protect their social position.

Isabelle is also a film about the passage of time on the body, on the hypocrisy and selfishness of human beings, on the courage and conscience with which, sooner or later, each of us is obliged to confront.

In 2008 his first feature movie, "Il Primo Giorno d'Inverno" (The First day of Winter) participates at 65th Venice Film Festival and was selected from more than twenty festival in Italy and all over the Europe.

In 2013 he founded the production company Strani Film with Giuditta Tarantelli and Fabio and Paolo Cavenaghi, and produced his second feature movie, "I Corpi Estranei" (Foreign Bodies) screened in competition at 8th Rome Film Festival, winner of many awards at International Festivals. In 2016 he produced with Strani Film "The cormorants", Fabio Bobbio's first feature film, in competition at Visions du Réel in Nyon. "Isabelle" is his third film.
